Youth Fine Painting and Calligraphy Art Contest

To promote the culture and history of Asian Americans, we would like to take the opportunity of the <u>China Boao</u> Education High-quality Development Conference to showcase the advanced achievements of contemporary aesthetic education. An exhibition of fine painting and calligraphy works for young people will be held during the Youth Art Education Innovation and Development Conference in May 2024. The Chinese American Association of Central Illinois (CAACI) is now soliciting outstanding art works from local students with painting and calligraphy specialties from the Champaign County.

1. Participants

Students with a global interest in painting and calligraphy. Student categories:

Elementary (upper/lower grade), middle school, high school, college students (under 24 years old)

2. Requirements for works

Theme

Peace, environmental protection, inheritance of history, gratitude for life.

Туре

Oil painting, gouache painting, watercolor, printmaking, drawing, traditional Chinese painting, children's painting, colored pencils, crayons, comics, computer painting, papercutting, cloth stickers, hard pen and soft pen calligraphy works, etc.

Size

Paintings must not exceed 40 cm x 60 cm (15.7 inches x 23.6 inches) and calligraphy works should not exceed 34.5 cm x 138 cm (13.5 inches x 54.3 inches).

3. Submission deadline

From now until April 20, 2024

Exhibition time: May 2024

Venue: Boao Forum for Asia International Conference Center, China

5. Exhibition features

Authoritative

As a featured activity of the 2024 China Boao Education High-quality Development Conference, this exhibition is initiated by the organizer of the conference. All participating artists after local selection will receive a certificate of participation issued by the organizer of the conference.

High visibility

The exhibition will be held at the Boao Forum for Asia International Conference Center, the host of the Boao Forum for Asia.

This exhibition will invite thousands of leaders and guests at all levels and outstanding educators to participate in the 2024 China Boao Education High-quality Development Conference.

Representativeness

The works collected in this collection will be displayed as representatives of the aesthetic education achievements of various regions and excellent education and training units.

Scarcity

This collection is limited to 500 works from North America.

Special arrangement

All the exhibited works are presented on the relevant materials and gift packaging of the 2024 China Boao Education High-quality Development Conference.

6. Other matters

- a. All entries should be submitted in high-resolution electronic format (photographed or scanned front, with clear light, JPG format) by April 20, 2024. Each artwork is required to be named as student category_grade_art title_artist name. The outstanding works selected by the local artistic judges from 40 North and the community will be sent to participate in the International Painting and Calligraphy Exhibition.
- b. The Chinese American Association of Central Illinois plans to host a local award ceremony, with a display of award-winning paintings and calligraphy, and an exhibition of art entries.
- c. Plagiarism and copying are strictly prohibited for creative manuscripts. Once found, the exhibition qualification will be cancelled.
- d. The right of authorship of the work belongs to the participating contestants. The copyright of the works belongs to the organizer.
- e. Registration and submission are required to use <u>this link</u>. Each application can submit one piece of artwork. Each participating artist can submit up to two pieces of artwork of different types in this contest.
